**AGREEMENT FOR STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAM BETWEEN PRINCE OF
SONGKLA UNIVERSITY AND REITAKU UNIVERSITY**

1. PURPOSE : Students of the Japanese Language Department, Reitaku University, will be sent to Prince of Songkla University in order to practice teaching Japanese as a Second Language and promote understanding of the culture and the language of Thailand.

2. PERIOD OF STUDY : As a rule, the study period of the student accepted will be limited to 16 weeks from November to the following March, that is, the second semester of Prince of Songkla University.

3. CURRICULUM : It is the responsibility of Prince of Songkla University to prepare an appropriate curriculum with the following courses.

Courses	Class Hours per Week
Thai Conversation	4
Thai Grammar	4
Japanese/Thai Contrastive Study	4
Thai Studies	4

4. TRANSFER OF CREDITS : Upon completion of this program, each Reitaku student will receive an official copy of his/her grade from Prince of Songkla University. All credits earned by Reitaku students while attending this program will be transferred to Reitaku University.

5. NUMBER OF STUDENTS TO BE ACCEPTED : Prince of Songkla University will accept a maximum number of 15 Reitaku students per semester.

6. PAYMENT OF FEES : The tuition and registration fees that Reitaku University will pay to Prince of Songkla University are as follows :

Tuition Fee : 120,000 Bht for the whole group of Reitaku students not exceeding 15.
(As long as the number of students is kept under 15, Prince of Songkla University guarantees to provide 20 class hours a week for 16 week.)

Dormitory Deposit : 1,500 Bht (To be refunded when leaving the dormitory)

Other expenses : 3,910 Bht (for activities, for library, for health, for handouts, etc.)

7. ROOM : It is the responsibility of Prince of Songkla University to provide a maximum number of 10 Reitaku students with rooms in the on-campus dormitories. The students will pay the regular fees for their rooms.

8. It is the responsibility of Prince of Songkla University to provide appropriate guidance for Reitaku students who attend this program.

9. Further details of this program shall be worked out through ad hoc consultation when this program is implemented.

10. This agreement is subject to annual review prior to the end of January and can be altered or cancelled by either party with one year's notice.

AGREEMENT FOR STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAM BETWEEN REITAKU UNIVERSITY AND PRINCE OF SONGKLA UNIVERSITY

1. PURPOSE: Students of Prince of Songkla University will be sent to Reitaku University in order to study the Japanese language and culture.

2. PERIOD OF STUDY: As a rule, the study period of the student accepted will be one or two semesters, from April to September and/or from September to the following March, at Reitaku University.

3. CURRICULUM: Students from Prince of Songkla University can choose suitable courses, according to their interest and level of Japanese and upon consultation with the teachers. The following groups of courses are available: "Japanese Language and Japanese Affairs" which is specially provided for undergraduate students from abroad; courses for the Japanese Department students; and courses of general education including Japanese History, History of Japanese Thought, Japanese Literature, and Folklore.

4. TRANSFER OF CREDITS: Upon completion of this program, each Prince of Songkla student will receive an official copy of his/her grade from Reitaku University. All credits earned by Prince of Songkla students while attending this program will be transferred to Prince of Songkla University.

5. NUMBER OF STUDENTS TO BE ACCEPTED: Reitaku University will accept a maximum number of 5 students from Prince of Songkla University per semester.

6. PAYMENT OF FEES: The tuition and other fees that Prince of Songkla students will pay to Reitaku University are as follows:

- Tuition Fee: (1) Language course: 15,000 yen per 90 minute class per week each semester
(2) Lecture course: 20,000 yen per 90 minute class per week each semester

Dormitory Fee: 216,000 yen per semester, or 432,000 yen per year which includes rental charges for bedding and electricity. It does not include meals, however.

Other expenses: Books, meals, health insurance, etc. will have to be paid by

7. **DORMITORY:** Reitaku University will provide a maximum number of 5 Prince of Songkla students with rooms in the on-campus dormitories. The students will pay the regular fees for their rooms.

8. Reitaku University will provide appropriate guidance for the Prince of Songkla students who attend this program.

9. Further details of this program shall be worked out through ad hoc consultation when this programme is implemented.

10. This agreement is subject to annual review prior to the end of September and can be altered or cancelled by either party with one year's notice.
