

**AGREEMENT OF ACADEMIC COOPERATION**  
**Between**  
**CHUNGNAM NATIONAL UNIVERSITY**  
**And**  
**PRINCE OF SONGKLA UNIVERSITY**

In recognition of their common interests in developing bilateral relations and being convinced that cooperation between institutes of higher learning contributes to cultural enrichment, scientific progress, and the consolidation of friendship between countries, Chungnam National University (hereinafter "CNU"), Daejeon, Republic of Korea, and Prince of Songkla University (hereinafter "PSU"), Hat Yai, Thailand, agree to establish the following Agreement of Academic Cooperation.

**I**

This agreement will promote activities in the following areas:

- Exchange of students
- Exchange of faculty and administrative staff
- Collaborative research projects, lectures, symposia, seminars, workshops, etc.
- Exchange of academic information and materials
- Collaboration in instructional and cultural programs, including publication activities of mutual interests and shared access to information networks.

**II**

Specific mechanisms for the implementation of particular cooperative and collaborative activities shall be established and described in writing by the responsible authority of each institution prior to the initiation of any particular program or activity.


**III**

1. All activities developed under the auspices of this Agreement will comply with the procedures, policies, and practices of each institution as well as the law and regulations of the host country.
2. Both institutions acknowledge that the visit by faculty and students from one institution to the other shall be subject to the entry and visa regulations of each country and shall comply with the regulations and policies of CNU and PSU.


**IV**

1. This Agreement is established for a period of five years, effective on the date of its signing.
2. In order to enhance the efficacy of their cooperative activities, CNU and PSU agree that it shall be possible to introduce changes and additions to the Agreement by means of mutually agreed upon additional written clauses.
3. At the end of each five-year period, this Agreement will be automatically renewed by mutual agreement for an additional five years, unless CNU or PSU provides written notification of a decision of non-renewal prior to the expiration date. A minimum period of six months notice will be required from either party wishing to terminate the Agreement. In the event of termination, all commitment to students participating in the program will be honored by relevant parties.

**AGREEMENT  
OF A STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAM  
BETWEEN  
CHUNGNAM NATIONAL UNIVERSITY  
AND  
PRINCE OF SONGKLA UNIVERSITY**

Chungnam National University (hereinafter called “CNU”) and Prince of Songkla University (hereinafter called “PSU”) will participate in the exchange of students under the following terms. These details will serve to provide the working framework for the academic exchange program.


1. The students are to be exchanged for either one full academic year or one semester.
2. Each academic year one institution will allow no more than 2 from the other institution to enroll as exchange students. The actual number of students to be exchanged will be determined every year by mutual consultation in advance.
3. The exchange students are required to be regular students who are registered in the bachelor, master, or doctoral program at the home institution.
4. The students who participate in the exchange program will be initially selected by the home institution, and the host institution will make the final decision of admission in each case.
5. The students will determine the detailed study plan at the host institutions in consultation with academic advisors of both home and host institutions.
6. The students must possess the level of language proficiency that is requested by the host institution in order to be accepted and complete the appropriate course of study.
7. The host institution will evaluate the academic performance of each student according to its rules and will send to the home institution the academic record/transcript of each exchange student. The home institution may give academic credits to each student according to its regulations.
8. The host institution will waive academic tuition and fees for the exchange students.
9. The students shall be responsible for their own expenses, including travel expenses, accommodation costs and health insurance fees.
10. The host institution will assist the students in finding adequate housing on or near the campus.

11. This agreement will enter into and be effective as of the date of its signing by the representatives of both institutions and shall be in force for the same period as the Agreement of Academic Cooperation.
12. Variation from the above terms may be possible by mutual consent.
13. This agreement is to be executed in the English language.


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
