



## LETTER OF MUTUAL UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

PRINCE OF SONGKLA UNIVERSITY, THAILAND

AND

CHIA NAN UNIVERSITY OF PHARMACY AND SCIENCE, TAIWAN

WHEREAS Prince of Songkla University, hereinafter referred to as PSU, and Chia Nan University of Pharmacy and Science, hereinafter referred to as CNU, are linked by common academic and cultural interests, and

WHEREAS these two institutions wish to enable cooperation and exchange to all academic areas of mutual interest, and

WHEREAS these two institutions wish to expand the basis for friendship and cooperative educational exchange between Thailand and Taiwan;

NOW, THEREFORE, PSU AND CNU set forth the contents of understanding which include, but are not limited to, the following:

- I. The development of collaborative research projects.
- II. The organization of joint academic and scientific activities, such as courses, conferences, seminars, or lectures.
- III. The exchange of research and teaching personnel.
- IV. The exchange of students.
- V. The exchange of academic materials and other information.

Cooperative projects under this general letter of mutual understanding may include any of the academic disciplines represented at either of the two institutions.

This letter of mutual understanding will come into force on the date of its signature by both Parties and will be amended by mutual written agreement of both institutions.

**International Dual Degree Agreement**  
**BETWEEN**  
**PRINCE OF SONGKLA UNIVERSITY, THAILAND**  
**AND**  
**CHIA NAN UNIVERSITY OF PHARMACY AND SCIENCE, TAIWAN**

Chia Nan University of Pharmacy and Science (CNU) agrees to implement the Dual Degree Program in conjunction with Prince of Songkla University (PSU) as stipulated in the terms below:


1. The program is to be brought into effect by the Department of Environmental Engineering and Science, CNU, and the Environmental Engineering Program, Department of Civil Engineering, PSU.
2. The program is valid following MOU between CNU and PSU.
3. The program's purpose is to help students of both universities to study in the two above-indicated units for a dual master degree, which will be jointly conferred upon the student by the two universities after he/she has fulfilled all the requirements as stated below:
  - a. Students from PSU have to finish 12 credits of required course works, 3 credits of selective course work, a seminar and 12 credits of thesis at PSU and 4 credits of course works, 6 credits of thesis with a minimum period of 9 months at CNU.
  - b. Students from CNU have to finish 12 credits of required course works, 6 credits of selective course works, a seminar and 6 credits of thesis at CNU and 12 credits of thesis with a minimum period of 9 months at PSU.
  - c. The student pays all required tuitions and fees at his/her home-country's university.
  - d. The student finishes a thesis (dissertation) within the stipulated time period and passes all required examination.
4. Host university will waive all the tuition and fees in the first academic year.
5. Students from CNU have to pay the tuitions and fees at a rate of 1.5 times of normal rate at the second academic year at PSU. Students from PSU have to pay the tuitions and fees at a normal rate at the second academic year at CNU.
6. To enter the program, the student must be a registered full-time postgraduate in either of the above-mentioned universities. In addition, the student must have the following qualifications:
  - a. Adequate English capability.
  - b. Adequate financial resources (accommodation, living expense and transportation).

7. To apply for admission to the program, the student must complete an application form, including all necessary information, and send it first to his/her home-country's university, and then to the foreign university for approval.
8. All students admitted to the program must arrive at the foreign university before a set deadline and follow all school regulations. Any student who wishes to extend or terminate his/her study, for any reason, must have the approval of both CNU and PSU beforehand.
9. Eligible faculty members of both universities can act as co-advisors of students in the program.
10. This agreement may be revised, but only with the consent of both universities. Any proposals for alteration of this agreement must be submitted to the concerned parties in such a manner as to allow sufficient time for consideration and for mutual understanding to be reached.


