

# **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

**BETWEEN**

**LINCOLN UNIVERSITY**

**CANTERBURY, NEW ZEALAND**

**AND**

**PRINCE OF SONGKLA UNIVERSITY**

**THAILAND**

## **1. PARTIES TO THE AGREEMENT**

1.1 **Lincoln University** of New Zealand, a body corporate under the Lincoln University Act 1961 hereinafter referred to as “Lincoln” and

1.2 **Prince of Songkla University** of Thailand, hereinafter referred to as “PSU”.

## **2. PRINCIPLES OF AGREEMENT**

2.1 Lincoln and PSU agree that they share common interests and that there will be mutual benefit from closer collaboration and joint ventures in training, research, consultancy, programme development and the exchange of staff, student and academic property.

2.2 All articles of the agreement will have respect for the character, organization, available resources and the corporate planning processes of each of the two institutions.

## **3. GENERAL AREAS OF COOPERATION**

Lincoln and PSU agree that subject to the availability of resources and the approval of both parties the following cooperative ventures will be considered.

3.1 Collaborative research

3.2 The exchange of staff

3.3 The exchange of students

3.4 Curriculum development activities

3.5 Staff development activities

3.6 The articulation of students between the two Universities

3.7 Study abroad programmes

**4. CONDITION**

The terms and conditions of any specific programmes that is agreed to under this Memorandum of Understanding will be discussed by both parties and agreed to in writing. The details of each university will be sent out in a schedule which will be appended to this Memorandum of Understanding.



**5. DURATION OF THE MEMORANDUM**
