Declaration

Prince of Songkla University, Hat Yai, Thailand and Waiariki Polytechnic, Rotorua, New Zealand have agreed to actively cooperate in a mutually beneficial association in a desire to strengthen the academic interaction between our two institutions as well as the better understanding of each other's nations.


Objectives

The principal objectives of this agreement will include :

- i) The facilitation of faculty and student exchange;
- ii) The encouragement of joint consultation on programme design, course curriculum, administration systems and other areas of mutual interest, and;
- iii) The provision for opportunities to undertake research and analysis on matters of mutual interest, and;
- iv) The sharing of the knowledge related to the sciences and technologies taught at our respective institutions, and;
- v) The creation among faculty, staff and students in both institutions of an awareness that we live in a global community and our need to work together.

In recognition of these and other activities of mutual benefit implemented by us, this Memorandum of Agreement is endorsed and approved by Dr. Siripongse Sribhibhadh, President, Prince of Songkla University, Hat Yai and Arapeta Tahana, Chief Executive Officer, Waiariki Polytechnic, Rotorua, who have signed this memorandum.


