

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between

PRINCE OF SONGKLA UNIVERSITY

and

THE ROBERT GORDON UNIVERSITY

on

ACADEMIC RESEARCH COLLABORATION

1. PARTIES TO COLLABORATION

WHEREAS, Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Prince of Songkla University, Thailand and the School of Pharmacy, The Robert Gordon University, United Kingdom, are mutually interested in establishing collaboration on academic and research related development activities.

WHEREAS, the two institutions have discussed the furtherance of these interests and now desire to record their mutual understandings in this regard.

NOW, THEREFORE, both parties hereby record their understanding.

2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding is to develop and carry out collaborative activities to further the common interest of the institutions set forth in Section 3.

3. **PRINCIPLE ASPECTS OF THE AGREEMENT**

The scope of collaboration of academic and research activities included in this Memorandum of Understanding includes the following categories:

- i) Training programmes, including degree and non-degree programmes;
- ii) Research collaboration in the areas of mutual interest to both parties;
- iii) Exchange of academic materials which are made available by both parties;
- iv) Exchange of scholars in the course of academic development to address problems of academic progress;
- v) Sponsorship of co-operative seminars, workshops and other academic meetings on matters of mutual interest.

4. **ACADEMIC ISSUES AND QUALITY CONTROL**

To implement the aims and purposes expressed in Section 2 and 3, the following is mutually understood and agreed:

- i) Proposals for collaborative work under this Memorandum will be submitted through the nominees of each institution;
- ii) Each university will nominate one of its members as its representative in charge of the co-operative programme. Individual programmes of work under this Memorandum will be jointly planned and conducted by the nominees of both parties;
- iii) Progress of work of the individual programme will be reviewed and approved by designated project officers of both parties;
- iv) The final approval of any project will be dependent upon the availability of guaranteed support funds.

5. **DURATION OF AGREEMENT**

- i) This Memorandum of Understanding is effective upon the date of signature by the representatives of the two institutions.

This Memorandum of Understanding may be amended at any time by mutual consent and shall remain in force unless terminated by either party by written notice received at least six (6) months in advance of said termination.


