

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

PRINCE OF SONGKLA UNIVERSITY

AND

UNIVERSITIES OF ENGLAND CONSORTIUM
FOR INTERNATIONAL ACTIVITIES

In furtherance of their mutual interest in the fields of education and training, research and development and as a contribution to increased international cooperation, the President of Prince of Songkla University and the Chief Executive of the Universities of England Consortium for International Activities have approved the following memorandum of understanding:

Article 1

The purposes of this general memorandum include, but are not limited, to the following:

- 1 Human resource and faculty development.
- 2 The organization of joint academic activities such as courses of training, conferences seminars, symposia and lectures.
- 3 The development of collaborative research projects.
- 4 The establishment of joint certificate, diploma and degree programmes.
- 5 The acquisition and implementation of collaborative development projects.

Article 2

In order to carry out and fulfil the goals of this memorandum of understanding each institution will appoint a coordinator for the development and management of joint activities. Through these contact persons either institution may initiate proposals for activities in a letter of agreement, which will become an integral part of the memorandum of understanding upon signing by appropriate authorities at both institutions. A letter of agreement will include such items as:

- 1 Elaboration of responsibilities of each institution for the activity.
- 2 Schedules for the implementation of the activity.
- 3 Budgets and sources of financing for the activity.
- 4 Any other items for the efficient management of the activity.


The contact person will be responsible for the evaluation of the activities under this memorandum of understanding according to the practices of their respective institutions. Letters of agreement will be approved at each institution according to the normal procedures for the type of activity proposed.

Article 3

This memorandum of understanding will come into force on the date of its signature by both parties and will be valid without time limitations. The memorandum may be amended by mutual agreement of both parties.

This memorandum of understanding may be terminated by either institution at any time provided that the terminating institution gives written notice of its intention to terminate at least six months prior to termination.
