

Memorandum of Understanding
between
Prince of Songkla University
and
University of Wales, Cardiff
on
Academic and Research Collaboration

WHEREAS, Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Prince of Songkla University, Thailand and Welsh School of Pharmacy, University of Wales, Cardiff are mutually interested in establishing collaboration on academic and research related development activities;

WHEREAS, the two institutions have discussed the furtherance of these interests and now desire to record their mutual understandings in this regard;

NOW, THEREFORE, both parties hereby record their understanding.

ARTICLE I

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding is to develop and carry out collaborative activities in further of the common interest of the institutions set forth in ARTICLE II.

ARTICLE II

The scope of collaboration of academic and research activities included in this Memorandum of Understanding includes the following categories:

1. Training programmes, including degree and non-degree programmes;
2. Research collaboration in the areas of mutual interest to both parties;
3. Exchange of academic materials which are made available by both parties;
4. Exchange of scholars in the course of academic development to address problems of academic progress;
5. Sponsors cooperative seminars, workshops and other academic meetings on matters of mutual interest.

ARTICLE III

To implement the aims and purposes expressed in ARTICLE I and II, the following is mutually understood and agreed :


1. Proposals of collaborative work under this Memorandum will be submitted through the nominees of each institution.
2. Each university will nominate one of its members as its representative in charge of the cooperative programme. Individual programmes of work under this Memorandum will be jointly planned and conducted by the nominees of both parties.

3. Progress of work of the individual programme will be reviewed and approved by designated project officers of both parties.
4. The final approval of any project will be dependent upon the availability of guaranteed support funds.
5. Neither Prince of Songkla University nor University of Wales, Cardiff will be held responsible for any liability whatsoever; furthermore, neither party shall be required to purchase any insurance against loss or damage to any personal property to which this agreement relates.


ARTICLE IV

2. This Memorandum of Understanding may be amended at any time of mutual consent and shall remain in force unless terminated by either party by written notice received at least six (6) months in advance of said termination.

IN WITNESS TO THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WHEREOF; the parties onto affix their signatures.




