

**Memorandum of Understanding
Between
Prince of Songkla University
And
Technical Research Centre of Finland (VTT)**

Prince of Songkla University (PSU), Thailand and Technical Research Center of Finland (VTT), Finland believe that mutual benefits can be derived by bridging their two organisations, achieving a closer relationship by linking their researchers, scholars, students, and personnel. Both organisations share the strong conviction that mutual understanding among people can be promoted through the establishment of academic links. Therefore, both organisations agree to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding.

Article I: Principle of Cooperation

PSU and VTT agree to develop their academic links under the principle of mutual understanding, mutual benefits, common interests, and mutually complementary activities.

Article II: Principle of Cooperation

- (1) to promote individual contacts among researchers, scholars, students, and personnel of both organisations,
- (2) to promote links in teaching, research, and cultural activities,
- (3) to provide opportunities for both researchers and students exchanges, however, such exchanges need not be equally reciprocated,
- (4) to develop and encourage joint research, seminars, conferences, workshops, and also assist each other in obtaining external funding from outside sources,
- (5) to support the exchange of academic materials,
- (6) to encourage any other activities that both organisations agree to be of mutual benefit.

Article III : Areas of Cooperation

Areas of cooperation can include any academic or other kind of programs offered by PSU and VTT.

Article IV : Implementation

It is understood and agreed that:


- (1) Proposals for collaborative projects under this MoU will be submitted through the Chief Executive Officer of PSU and through the Vice President of VTT (Energy, Strategic Research) ,

- (2) To encourage researcher and student mobilization, the host organisation will assist in every way it could in finding reasonable accommodation for participating researchers or students.
- (3) Financial arrangements for collaborative research, seminars, workshops, conferences, and other such activities will be negotiated separately and will be subject to the availability of funds.

Article V : Duration and Termination of the Agreement

- (1) This MoU is effective as of the date of signature by the Chief Executive Officer of each participating organisation.
- (2) This MoU may be amended at any time as indicated by written mutual consent. This MoU may be terminated by either organisation by the provision of written notice of termination not less than six months prior to the desired termination date.


