

**Memorandum of Understanding
Between
Prince of Songkla University, Thailand
And
The University of Aveiro, Portugal**

Prince of Songkla University, Thailand and the University of Aveiro, Portugal, wishing to establish relations between the two institutions, agree to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding.

Principle of Cooperation

The areas of cooperation include any program offered at either institution as thought desirable and feasible on their side or that both sides think will contribute to the development of the cooperative relationship between the two universities.

Areas of Cooperation

Cooperation shall be carried out through such activities as:


- a. Exchange of students and staff members,
- b. Joint consultancy activities in obtaining external funding from outside sources,
- c. Academic cooperation in relations to:
 - Collaborative research activities
 - Joint supervision of students,
 - Participation in seminars, workshops and academic meetings,
 - Exchange of academic materials, research publication and other information,
 - Special short-term academic programs.

Duration and Termination of the Agreement

- (1) The terms of cooperation for each specific activity implemented under this Memorandum of Understanding shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both parties to the initiation of that activity.
- (2) This Memorandum of Understanding shall remain in force for a period of three years. Its validity can be terminated within three years with a written notice with the personal signature of the representatives to another side three months before the desirable terminating date.
- (3) This agreement can be extended by mutual written consent of the two parties.


