

**AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
PRINCE OF SONGKLA UNIVERSITY,
THE UNIVERSITY OF CHIANG MAI
AND
SIMON FRASER UNIVERSITY**

This Agreement, between Simon Fraser University in British Columbia, Canada, and The University of Chiang Mai and Prince of Songkla University in Thailand is established to govern the administration of funds collected and held in trust by Simon Fraser University for and The University of Chiang Mai and Prince of Songkla University.

The purpose of this Agreement is to strengthen existing educational, research and personal ties between the students, faculty and staff of Simon Fraser University and the students, faculty and staff of The University of Chiang Mai and Prince of Songkla University through a responsible use of available funding.

1. This Agreement specifically governs those funds collected as tuition payments from students participating in Simon Fraser University's Southeast Asia Field School (hereafter the "Funds") in return for agreed-upon teaching duties delivered during the Southeast Asia Field School program. Unless otherwise previously agreed, these teaching duties will be delivered without remuneration.
2. The Funds will be collected at the regular rates of tuition as applied to courses and credit hours taught at Simon Fraser University. Monies collected as Student Society Dues or Student Activity Fees are not governed by this Agreement.
3. The Funds collected will be held in trust at Simon Fraser University for the use of The University of Chiang Mai and Prince of Songkla University. Any change in the administration of this principle must be agreed to in writing by appropriate representatives of both universities at least three months prior to said change.
4. The Funds will be used for the following items:
 - i) to support international travel to and from Simon Fraser University for designated faculty and staff of The University of Chiang Mai and Prince of Songkla University.
 - ii) to support accommodation and living expenses for designated visitors to Simon Fraser University at a minimum amount of Cad \$800.00 per month.
 - iii) to support the purchase of minor equipment, supplies and materials necessary for research and communication links.
5. All visitors from The University of Chiang Mai and Prince of Songkla University entering Simon Fraser University as instructors, graduate students or researchers under the terms of this Agreement will be governed by the relevant admission and academic policies of Simon Fraser University.

Memorandum of Understanding
between
Simon Fraser University
and
Prince of Songkla University

With this Memorandum of Understanding, Simon Fraser University, Burnaby, British Columbia, Canada, and Prince of Songkla University, Hat Yai, Thailand, agree to recognize on another as affiliated institutions and to cooperate where feasible and mutually acceptable in the following areas :

- the exchange of staff, students and materials
- the sharing of information of mutual interest
- the development of faculty level linkages
- the exploration of shared research and teaching interests
- the promotion of academic, economic and social development in Thailand
- other initiatives likely to promote academic cooperation
- the promotion of understanding between the peoples of Thailand and Canada.

Ratification of this Memorandum of Understanding will not result in any material, financial or other obligation for either of the two universities. Both universities will be at liberty to determine the financing of their joint initiatives in accordance with their respective policies.

This Memorandum is effective for an unlimited duration, but may be terminated by either university with sufficient written notice being given to the other university.
