SITE LICENSE AGREEMENT

With regard to the relationship between N.T.U./Thailand, Ltd. (hereinafter referred to as NTU/Thailand), Thailand distributor of programs offered by the National Technological University (hereinafter referred to as NTU), Prince of Songkla University (hereinafter referred to as "PSU"), the following provisions are agreed upon:

General Provisions

1. PSU and NTU/Thailand will work with each other in good faith to comply with their respective responsibilities as set forth in the NTU bulletin and any subsequent updates or replacements.
2. In this spirit of good faith, PSU agrees to make a minimum five (5) year commitment, commencing on the date of this agreement, to participate in the NTU program. (This commitment is necessary to assure PSU's employees and/or students that the NTU program will be available for them to complete their master's degree if one is offered.)
3. In addition to the utilization of NTU graduate credit programs, which shall be governed by a later addendum referencing this document (see provision #5 below), PSU shall have access to NTU's non-credit Advanced Technology & Management Programs (ATMP), short courses and seminars. Published tuition and registration fees will apply.
4. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of Thailand. PSU agrees to submit to the jurisdiction of the courts of Thailand for resolution of disputes arising under this Agreement.
5. If the future best interests of NTU/Thailand and PSU would be served by adding one or more provisions to this Agreement, it shall be done by an addendum referencing this document and signed by both parties.

Specific Provisions

NTU/Thailand agrees to:

1. provide the facilities and services essential to the fulfillment of its mission;
2. strive for the refinement and development of technological means and academic support services to enhance the quality of its services;
3. maintain a process of on-going updates for PSU's on-site administrators of NTU programs and services to ensure progress toward the achievement of its institutional goals;
4. support a mutually agreed-upon program for strategic course/seminar planning and needs assessment.

PSU agrees to:

1. provide and maintain those facilities and resources needed to receive the NTU instruction transmitted via satellite, videotape and telecommunications technology to the receiving site(s). Such facilities and resources shall include:
 - ◊ a satellite receiving system;
 - ◊ an IRD unit set to receive programs of NTU;
 - ◊ video recording and replaying equipment;
 - ◊ class and conference rooms;
 - ◊ a computer terminal and telecommunications equipment;
 - ◊ laboratory facilities and equipment;
 - ◊ library services;
 - ◊ a site education coordinator;
 - ◊ instructional support personnel

[For detailed information concerning each of these facilities and resources, see the NTU Sponsoring Site Operational Procedures Manual. NTU reserves the right to change facility/resource requirements as it deems necessary to enhance the quality of its services.];

2. support the NTU admission policy and procedures process. Applicants should be considered only if sponsored by their employer, an affiliated organization, or are admitted to a public seminar or course organized by PSU. This sponsorship will take the form of a recommendation of each applicant by his or her employer and supervisor, or through registration for the course by PSU;
3. ensure that any person viewing an NTU academic course is other: a) a student registered for credit; b) a viewer registered for audit; or c) an educational coordinator or facilitator authorized by PSU. PSU has the responsibility to assure compliance with this provision;
4. ensure academic integrity of the on-site examination process;
5. honor U.S. copyright laws as they apply to documentation and broadcast material;
6. be accountable for erasing tapes as specified in the registration materials, and provide (through the site coordinator) written confirmation of acquisition of a license or of the erasure of the tapes;
7. support a mutually agreed-upon program for strategic course/seminar planning and needs assessment;
8. provide reasonable access to its facilities to allow representatives of higher education agencies and accrediting bodies to observe the NTU instructional process.
