THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING is made on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of July 2016

**BETWEEN**

**UNIVERSITI SAINS ISLAM MALAYSIA**, an institution of higher learning incorporated under the Universiti Sains Islam Malaysia (Incorporation Order) 2007 [P.U. (A) 31/2007 ] and established under the Universities and University Colleges Act 1971 and having its correspondence address at Bandar Baru Nilai, 71800 Nilai, Negeri Sembilan DarulKhusus, Malaysia (hereinafter referred to as "USIM") and will include its lawful representatives and permitted assigns on the one part;

**AND**

**PRINCE OF SONGKLA UNIVERSITY** an institution of higher learning in Thailand and having its correspondence address at Karnjanavanich Road, Hat Yai, Songkhla 90110, Thailand (hereinafter referred to as "PSU") and will include its lawful representatives and permitted assigns on the other part;

**AND**

**INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY FOR RENEWAL** an institution of higher learning in Turki and having its correspondence address at Evren Mahallesi, Cami Yolu Sk, No. 5/51 34212, Bagcilar, Istanbul, Turkey. (hereinafter referred to as "IUR") and will include its lawful representatives and permitted assigns on the other part;



USIM, PSU and IUR shall hereinafter be referred to singularly as "the Party" and collectively as "the Parties".

**WHEREAS:-**

- A. **USIM** is an established public university in Malaysia which strives to enhance and strengthen its tertiary-level education training in a wide spectrum of academic disciplines via various collaborative arrangements with other parties.
- B. **PSU** is a public comprehensive university which strives to enhance and strengthen its research and teaching expertise and support regional industry and development.
- C. **IUR** is an university which offers bachelors, masters and PhD programmes. It has all equipment for researches and wish to strengthen its research and development Programme.
- D. The Parties are desirous of entering into this Memorandum of Understanding to declare their respective intentions and to establish a basis of co-operation and collaboration between the Parties upon the terms as contained herein.

**THE PARTIES HAVE REACHED AN UNDERSTANDING** as follows:

**ARTICLE I**

**OBJECTIVE**

The Parties, subject to the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding and the laws, rules, regulations and national policies from time to time in force in each Party's country, will endeavour to strengthen, promote and develop on a basis of direct cooperation and collaboration in the field of research, education and in training programs on the basis of equality and mutual benefit.



## ARTICLE II

### AREAS OF COOPERATION

1. Each Party will, subject to the laws, rules, regulation and national policies from time to time in force, governing the subject matter in their respective countries, endeavour to take necessary steps to encourage and promote cooperation in the following areas:
  - (a) Joint conference;
  - (b) Joint research and supervision (to be mutually agreed);
  - (c) Joint publication;
  - (d) Researcher/Faculty/Student Attachment and exchange;
  - (e) Summer School, Short courses and Training; and
  - (f) Any other co-operation mutually agreed upon by the Parties.
  
2. For the purpose of implementing the co-operation in respect of any area stated in paragraph 1, the Parties will enter into a legally binding agreement subject to terms and conditions as mutually agreed upon by the Parties including clauses on "confidentiality", "suspension", "protection of intellectual property rights" and "settlement of dispute".

## ARTICLE III

### FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

1. This Memorandum of Understanding will not give rise to any financial obligation by one Party to the other.
2. Each Party shall bear its own cost and expenses in relation to this Memorandum of Understanding.

**EFFECT OF MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

Nothing contained herein is to be construed so as to constitute a joint venture partnership or formal business organization of any kind between the Parties or so to constitute either Party as the agent of the other.

**ARTICLE VI**  
**ENTRY INTO EFFECT AND DURATION**

1. This Memorandum of Understanding will come into effect on the date of signing and will remain in effect for a period of **One (1)** year.
2. This Memorandum of Understanding may be extended for a further period as may be agreed in writing by the Parties.
