

*Memorandum of understanding
Between
International University of Africa
And
Prince of Songkla University
(Thailand)*

To strengthen relations between academic institutions in Sudan and Thailand and to further cooperation in the fields of education, training and research , the two universities agreed upon the following:

- 1- Exchange of Academic staff in various capacities e.g visiting , sabbatical and external examiners.
- 2- Training of academic staff of the other university to obtain higher academic qualifications in specialisations needed by that university. The hosting university waives tuition fees.
- 3- Facilitations of students' exchange programmes.
- 4- Recognition of equivalent courses among the various programmes and accordingly grant recognition, exemption or transfer of credits as needed.
- 5- Joint organization of conferences, seminars and workshops that are of interest to the two universities.
- 6- Exchange of publications, theses and periodicals published at each university.
- 7- Both parties are in full understanding of the financial impact when executing these activities and these will be arrived at through mutual understanding and will be annexed to this MOU.
- 8- This agreement will remain in force for five years and will be renewed by mutual agreement for similar periods and its termination by either party, requires six months notice.

In witness whereof the parties hereunto have signed this Memorandum of Understanding at the IUA Khartoum on Monday June the 20th 2005.
