

China Southwest University of Political Science and Law (CSUPSL) and Prince of Songkla University (PSU) Cooperation Agreement

Addendum for 2000-2001

This addendum is made in order to continue the academic cooperation between China Southwest University of Political Science and Law (CSUPSL) and Prince of Songkla University (PSU). This addendum will be reviewed at the end of 2001 to reflect the financial capabilities of both universities at that time.

1. Academic Staff Exchange

1.1 CSUPSL agrees to receive four (4) staff members from PSU each year for a visit of not more than two-weeks each.

Financial Arrangement

1.1 PSU's staff to CSUPSL:

CSUPSL will provide either meals for a 1-7 day visit or a living allowance for a 8-14 day-visit at a rate of 70 Yuan/day/person, free accommodation on campus and one way air ticket or round trip train tickets between Kunming and Chongqing.

1.2 CSUPSL's staff to PSU:

PSU relevant Faculty will provide either meals for a 1-7 day visit or a living allowance in Hat Yai or Pattani for a 8-14 day visit at a rate of 300- 400 baht/day/person. In addition, PSU will

provide free accommodation on campus and one way air ticket or round trip train tickets between Bangkok and Hat Yai.

2. Student Exchange

2.1 CSUPSL agrees to receive five (5) students each year from PSU for a period of up to two-months. They will audit the classes and receive a (P) Pass or a U (Unsatisfactory).

2.2 PSU agrees to receive five (5) students or teachers each year from CSUPSL for a period of up to two months. The visiting CSUPSL students or teachers should be able to communicate in English.

Financial Arrangement

2.1 PSU's students to CSUPSL:

CSUPSL will provide free meals and free accommodation on campus

2.2 CSUPSL's students or teachers to PSU:

PSU will provide living allowances at a rate of 4,000 baht/month/person as well as free accommodation on campus.

3. Executive Visit

- * The executive officers can be Presidents, Vice Presidents, Deans, Deputy Deans, Heads of Department and Heads of Administrative Staff.
- * The number of people allowed can be between 5-8 each year.
- * The length of each visit should not be more than 7 days.
- * The visit can be arranged through the exchange of letters.

Financial Arrangement

3.1 PSU to CSUPSL:

CSUPSL will provide free meals, free accommodation on campus, round trip air tickets between Kunming and Chongqing and not more than 2 nights accommodation, meals or living allowance of 80 yuan per day per person and transportation in Kunming.

3.2 CSUPSL to PSU:

PSU and/or relevant Faculties will provide free meals. In addition, PSU will provide free accommodation on campus, round trip air tickets between Bangkok and Hat Yai and not more than 2 nights accommodation in Bangkok, meals or living allowance of 400 baht per day per person and transportation in Bangkok.

4. Training Program

4.1 CSUPSL agrees to receive two staff members from PSU each year for a training program in Chinese language/law and business at postgraduate certificate level for one semester.

4.2 PSU agrees to receive two staff members or students from CSUPSL each year for a training program for one semester.

4.3 Areas of the exchange in items 4.1 - 4.2 will be discussed by exchange of letters.

Financial Arrangement

4.1 PSU's staff to CSUPSL:

CSUPSL will provide a monthly salary at a rate of 1,800 Yuan as well as free accommodation on campus.

4.2 CSUPSL's staff/students to PSU:

PSU and/or relevant Faculty will provide a monthly salary at a rate of 9,000 baht for staff and at a rate of 4,000 baht for student as well as free accommodation for both on campus.

5. Short Study Tour

5.1 PSU expects to send a group of master's degree students in Business Administration, Public Administration or MINI MBA to CSUPSL for a short study tour. CSUPSL will arrange transportation, accommodation, and a visiting program with relevant government agencies and private firms.

5.2 CSUPSL expects to send a group of master's degree students and undergraduate students to PSU for a short study tour. PSU will arrange transportation, accommodation, and visiting program in Hat Yai at a reasonable price. In addition, PSU will help arrange a visiting program to Singapore and Malaysia as well. However, the transportation and accommodation in Singapore and Malaysia will have to be arranged by a tour company at the going rate at that

time.

Financial Arrangement

All of the expenses will be borne by the students.

6. Research Collaboration

PSU and CSUPSL staff are encouraged to jointly submit research proposals to funding agencies and/or PSU's collaborative research fund. For PSU's research fund, financial arrangements will be as follows:

(1) PSU's people to CSUPSL:

PSU assumes all the expenses while CSUPSL provides working space and access to equipment and the library.


(2) CSUPSL's people to PSU:

PSU will provide living allowance at a rate of 400 baht/day and free accommodation on campus. A one-way air ticket between Chongqing and Bangkok and round trip air tickets between Bangkok and Hat Yai will also be provided by PSU.

7. Anything not covered in this agreement will be settled through consultation and exchange of letters by both universities.
