

**Jiangxi Normal University (JXNU)**  
**And**  
**Prince of Songkla University (PSU)**  
**Cooperation Agreement**

*Addendum for 2014-2015*

This addendum is made in order to continue the academic cooperation between Prince of Songkla University (PSU), Thailand, and Jiangxi Normal University (JXNU), P.R. China. The addendum will be reviewed at the end of 2015 to reflect the commitment of both universities at that time.

**1. Staff Exchange**

1.1 Academic Staff Exchange

PSU and JXNU agree to receive up to four (4) staff members from the counterpart university each year for one week visit. These staff should prepare a presentation for fifteen (15) minutes in English about their work including the area of their expertise.

1.2 Executive Visit

Each university agrees to receive six (6) executive officers during 2014 – 2015 for one week visit. The executive officers may be President, Vice President, Deans, Deputy Deans, Heads of Department, or Heads of Administrative Staff.

Financial Arrangement for Staff Exchange

The host university will provide lodging and meals. The host university also provides airport picked-up and local transportation in Hat Yai or in Nanchang, respectively.

**2. Student Exchange**

2.1 Cultural Exchange Program

Both universities agree to receive a group of (10) students and two (2) staff each year for a two weeks visit from the counterpart university.

Financial Arrangement

The host university will provide lodging and meals. The host university also provides round-trip train tickets between Guangzhou and Nanchang or between Bangkok and Hat Yai, and hotel in Guangzhou or Bangkok up to two nights.

2.2 Student Practical Training

Both universities agree to receive four (4) students each year from the counterpart university for a period of two months. The students must be fluent in English. Each party will try their best to place the students studying in Business Administration in the private company or business organization.

Financial Arrangement for Practical Training Students

The host university will provide free lodging and living allowances. The host university also provides round-trip train tickets between Guangzhou and Nanchang or between Bangkok and Hat Yai, and hotel in Guangzhou or Bangkok up to two nights.

2.3 Student Exchange for Study Abroad

Both universities agree to receive two undergraduate students from the counterpart university each year to study for a period of one or two academic years.

**Remarks:** PSU students may choose to study at JXNU for one or two semesters. If PSU students study at JXNU for shorter period than JXNU students do at PSU, PSU can send more students to be equivalent.

Financial Arrangement

The host university will provide lodging and the tuition fees will be waived. Other expenses will be borne by the exchanged student.

### 3. Joint Research

Both universities agree to do their utmost to develop at least one joint research project by 2015.

#### Financial Arrangement

The host university will provide lodging, meals, and waive the bench fee for the relevant researchers.

### 4. Visiting Professors

PSU is pleased to receive visiting professors from JXNU. The duration of their stay will usually vary from one semester to one year. Details will depend on mutual agreement on a case by case basis.

#### Financial Arrangement

PSU relevant faculty will provide salary (depending upon qualification, experiences and academic position) and lodging during the period of stay, as well as roundtrip air fares between Bangkok and Guangzhou, while PSU will provide a round-trip air ticket between Hat Yai and Bangkok.

### 5. The Development of MOU between PSU Faculty of Fine and Applied Arts and JXNU Faculty of Music

Both universities agree to encourage the development of MOU between PSU Faculty of Fine and Applied Arts and JXNU Faculty of Music in order to support academic activities e.g. cultural exchange program, visiting professor, joint seminars and art exhibitions, joint research, etc. Further detailed and other necessary commitments will be directly discussed between the two faculties.

### 6. Health Insurance

Both staff and students from the two universities must have the international medical insurance prior to their departure from the home country. However, the host university will facilitate them to the hospitals, clinics or nursing homes in case of any sickness or accidents.

**7. Both universities agree not to allow suspended quotas to cross over to the following year in the event they are not able to send staff or students to one another within the designated year.**

**8. Anything not in this agreement will be settled through consultation and mutual agreement by both parties.**


